The ministry of Jesus on earth was so successful because he knew who he was and what he had. It is the will of Jesus that we do greater than he did. But this can only be accomplished if we are conscious of who we are in him and all he has given us.

# CHAPTER I

## GOD'S LOVE

### **Romans 8:38-39**

“For I am persuaded, that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers, nor things present, nor things to come, nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature, shall be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.”

Many people have a wrong perception of God. God does not just love, God is love. Love is who he is.

And the fullness of his love is directed to man.

He demonstrated his love for us when he sent His first begotten son, who was then His only begotten son, to die for the sinful world. He continues to demonstrate his love today, but we can only enjoy the full benefit of His love when we begin to understand just how much he loves us.

### **Ephesians 3:19:**

“And to know the love of Christ, which passeth knowledge, that ye might be filled with all the fullness of God”

Paul was praying for the church at Ephesus that they have a revelation of the love of God that surpasses human and natural knowledge. In other words, God loves us so much that the human mind can't even comprehend it. God is saying that when we have a revelation of His love we will be filled with his fullness.

### **Ephesians 2:5-6:**

“But God, who is rich in mercy, for his great love wherewith he loved us, even when we were dead in sins, hath quickened us together with Christ, by grace ye are saved”

God loved us in our worst state. While we were yet sinners, he sent his son to die for us. I often ask myself what we did to deserve this love. The answer is nothing. He created us as objects for his love.

## **THE DEPTH OF GOD'S LOVE**

In Ephesians 3:18, Paul prayed for the church that they know the height, length and depth of God's love. To many Christian, 'God loves you' has become just a religious cliché'. They don't have a clue of just how much he loves and values them.

The truth is that God the father does not love Jesus more than he loves you. The bible clearly states that. Jesus declared it himself while he was praying in John chapter 17.

### **John 17:23:**

“I in them, and thou in me, that they may be made perfect in one; and that the world may know that thou hast sent me, and hast loved them, as thou hast loved me”

While Jesus was on earth, he was conscious of this love, this consciousness made him fearless and confident wherever he went. He had total faith in the love of the Father and was filled with the fullness of God. He was so conscious of God’s love that he declared it in his conversations and teachings.

**John 5:20:**

“For the Father loves the Son, and shows him all things that himself doeth: and he will show him greater works than these that ye may marvel”

The good news is that the father himself loves you. (John 16:27).

## **JESUS’ LOVE**

Jesus is one with the father. And he loves us just as much as the father loves us. He displayed the greatest level of love when he chose to die for the world.

**John 15:13:**

“Greater love hath no man than this; that a man lay down his life for his friends”

Follow closely as we explore Jesus’ intimate love from the book of Ephesians

**Ephesians 5:28-32:**

28 So ought men to love their wives as their own bodies. He that loves his wife loves himself.

29 For no man ever yet hated his own flesh; but nourisheth and cherisheth it, even as the Lord the church:

30 For we are members of his body, of his flesh, and of his bones.

31 For this cause shall a man leave his father and mother, and shall be joined unto his wife, and they two shall be one flesh.

32 This is a great mystery: but I speak concerning Christ and the church.

**Verse 28 says:** he that loves his wife loves himself

**Verse 29 says:** Jesus loves the church the way every man loves, nurtures and cherishes himself.

**Verse 30:** we are members of his body, flesh and bones. 4

**31 and 32 says:** we are the bride of Christ and we are one with him.

This is big, this is very big. From verse 29, we see that Jesus loves us the same way he loves himself. Meditate on this for some time. We are his bride!

We are greatly, dearly and intimately loved by God.

The devil is aware that if the body of Christ is conscious of God's love we will walk, talk and act with so much authority and confidence just like Jesus did. That's why he tries to make many Christians feel condemned and unworthy. But you

are valuable. God takes pleasure in you (Psalm

149:4), he likes you. He loves you. You are a sweet-smelling savor unto him (2 Corinthians 2:15). He wants to fellowship with you daily. The bible says perfect love casteth fear (1 John 4:18). However, the devil wants us to be in the bondage because of fear. Fear loses its grip over you the moment you realize God's perfect love for you.

**Luke 1:30:**

“And the angel said unto her, Fear not, Mary: for thou hast found favor with God”

So, fear not, you have found favor with God. All things work together for your good (Romans 8:28). Be anxious for nothing (Philippians 4:6).

**Isaiah 62:4**

“Thou shalt no more be termed Forsaken; neither shall thy land any more be termed desolate but thou shalt be called Hephzibah, and thy land Beulah: for the Lord delighteth in thee and thy land shall be married.”

# CHAPTER II

## GRACE & RIGHTEOUSNESS

### **Romans 5:17**

For if by one man's offence death reigned by one; much more they which receive abundance of grace and of the gift of righteousness shall reign in life by one, Jesus Christ.)

Grace is unmerited favor. Grace is the hand of God upon a person's life. Grace is the divine influence causing a person to be unusually favored and blessed. Righteousness is right standing with God. It is a state of perfection.

The question now is- "How can I become righteous?" and "How can I obtain grace?" The good news is that grace is available for everyone through Jesus.

### **John 1:17**

"...Grace and truth came by Jesus Christ."

*Grace birthed salvation.*

### **Ephesians 2:8-9**

“For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: Not of works, lest any man should boast.”

*Righteousness is not worked for but gifted by grace.*

### **John 1:16**

“And of his fullness have all we received, and grace for grace.”

By the life, suffering, death and resurrection of Jesus, we have received grace, grace that is sufficient. The grace of God is available for every person. Jesus died for the world. It is left for every sinner to believe and accept this grace and righteousness in the person of Jesus.

## **THE GIFT OF RIGHTEOUSNESS**

Notice that in Romans 5:17, righteousness is referred to as a gift.

A gift is different from a wage as stated below:

### **Romans 4:4 (NIV)**

“Now to the one who works, wages are not credited to him as a gift but as an obligation.”

Sadly, many Christians think of righteousness as a wage, something that you work for or deserve or earn; but this kind of righteousness is not acceptable in the sight of God.

### **Romans 10:2-3**

“For I bear them record that they have a zeal of God, but not according to knowledge. For they, being ignorant of God's righteousness, and going

about to establish their own righteousness, have not submitted themselves unto the righteousness of God.”

This verse clearly states that there is a righteousness of God. That is, righteousness accepted in the sight of God.

Follow closely as we look at the nature of that righteousness.

### **Philippians 3:9**

“And to be found in him, not having mine own righteousness, which is of the law, but that which is through the faith of Christ, the righteousness which is of God by faith.”

Paul clearly described the righteousness of God here, which is the righteousness of God by faith. Faith in what? --

Faith in Jesus, faith in his death, burial and resurrection. Faith in the fact that we are not righteous because of what we do or what we do not do; but we are righteous because Jesus is our High Priest and he has made us righteous. Faith in the finished works of Christ!

### **Romans 4:5**

“But to him that worketh not, but believeth on him that justifieth the ungodly, his faith is counted for righteousness.”

God wants us to live right, but he wants us to live right because of the consciousness that we are righteous. He wants all the credit for our righteousness.

Get this-- we are righteous because Jesus is righteous. There is no righteousness outside faith in Jesus.

## **Galatians 2:21**

“I do not frustrate the grace of God: for if righteousness come by the law, then Christ is dead in vain.”

## **CONDEMNATION**

Condemnation is one of Satan’s biggest weapons against believers. He knows that when a Christian feels condemned his relationship with God is weakened in his mind.

## **1John 3:21**

“Beloved, if our heart condemn us not, then have we confidence toward God.”

I once sensed spiritual dryness in a friend, then I asked him what the problem was. He said he was afraid to pray because he had done so many bad things, he said he felt unworthy and he thought that if he prayed to God, God would strike him down for having the audacity to approach him with so much filth in his cupboard.

The problem here was not the sins he had committed; the problem was that He was unaware that in Jesus he was holy and righteous. He was unaware that God is calling everyone into reconciliation with Him and that He isn’t counting any body’s sin against them. Yeah, God does not count your sins against you.

## **2 Corinthians 5:17-19**

“Therefore, if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new. And all things are of God, who hath reconciled us to himself by Jesus Christ, and hath given to us the ministry of reconciliation; To wit, that God was in Christ, reconciling the world unto himself, not imputing their trespasses unto

them; and hath committed unto us the word of reconciliation.”

### **Romans 4:4-8**

“But to him that worketh not, but believeth on him that justifieth the ungodly, his faith is counted for righteousness. Even as David also describeth the blessedness of the man, unto whom God imputeth righteousness without works, saying, blessed are they whose iniquities are forgiven, and whose sins are covered. Blessed is the man to whom the Lord will not impute sin.”

### **Romans 6:18**

“Being then made free from sin, ye became the servants of righteousness.”

The bible says we are dead to sin and servants to righteousness. That’s just amazing.

## **GOD HAS NOT GONE SOFT ON SIN**

God “hates” sin. He will never like sin. That was why he did something about it. In Christ, God killed sin and our sinful nature.

The bible says Christ became sin for us. When Jesus died, sin died for those who are in Christ.

### **2Corinthians 5:21**

“For he hath made him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him.”

When Christ died, we died. Not only is sin dead. But our sinful nature died too. When Christ died, we all died! Everybody was punished in

Christ. Our sinful nature died with the death of Christ.

### **2Corinthians 5:14**

“For the love of Christ constraineth us; because we thus judge, that if one died for all, then were all dead.”

### **Colossians 3:3**

“We are dead.”

“The soul that sins shall die”. Death is the punishment for sins. Not penance or pleading. The consequence of sin is death. But praise be to God, Christ died the death we all deserved. When Christ died, we died in Him. When he resurrected, we resurrected in him.

### **Romans 6:6-7**

“Knowing this, that our old man is crucified with him, that the body of sin might be destroyed, that henceforth we should not serve sin. For he that is dead is freed from sin.”

So, we live righteous not to become righteous, but we live righteous because we are righteous. Having this consciousness will transform your life, you'll realize that you no longer do the wrong things and that you are confident to approach God and fellowship with him anytime.

And Satan will lose his ability to make you doubt or feel unworthy. Never feel unworthy. 1John 3:20

For if our heart condemns us, God is greater than our heart, and knoweth all things.

## **WHY DO SOME CHRISTIANS STRUGGLE WITH SIN?**

The reason why many Christians do not live as they should is because they fail to continually renew their minds with the word of God.

Many Christians seem to lack even the basic virtues every Christian should possess.

### **2Peter 1:9**

“...He that lacketh these things is blind, and cannot see afar off, and has forgotten that he was purged from his old sins.”

Many forget that they are righteous. Many haven't even been told or taught before. They still consider themselves as the same person who struggled with sins before encountering Christ. They don't know they have a new spirit; they don't know they have been made righteous. Many forget they are the temple of God. They allow negative influences from the world rule their minds. They allow evil surround them and accept the words and teachings of carnal people. They get comfortable seeing themselves in the likeness of their old selves.

### **James 1:22-25:**

“But be doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves. 23 For if anyone is a hearer of the word and not a doer, he is like a man observing his natural face in a mirror; 24 for he observes himself, goes away, and immediately forgets what kind of man he was. 25 But he who looks into the perfect law of liberty and continues in it and is not a forgetful hearer but a doer of the work, this one will be blessed in what he does.”

We see here that we ought to be doers of the words and not just hearers. In other words, knowing that we are righteous, we are expected to bear

fruits of righteousness. Anyone who does not bear these righteous fruits is like a man who beholds his self in the mirror and forgets what he looks like. This means he fails to remain conscious of his image.

This is the crux of the matter. Righteousness consciousness! We must continue to behold ourselves in God's mirror. God's mirror says we are righteous, we have to continually behold and remember this truth.

Apart from proper study, there are two other things which greatly hinders this consciousness—prayerlessness and negative influences. We need to be mindful of who we spend time with. Can people don't have righteousness consciousness. We tend to think and talk like the people we spend most of our time with. Prayerlessness is perhaps even more detrimental. Something amazing happens when we pray, it is almost like our mind is fine-tuned to the frequency of God. We begin to think, talk and act like our father the more time we spend with him. Prayerlessness wanes that frequency.

Become conscious of who you are. Lions do not bark, dogs do not lay eggs, Christians do not sin.

The reason we do not sin is because we know who we have become in Christ.

We no longer identify with our former selves. You might have been a liar before you received Christ, but that liar is dead now. You are a different person.

### **Colossians 3:9-10**

“Lie not one to another, seeing that ye have put off the old man with his deeds;

10 And have put on the new man, which is renewed in knowledge after the image of him that created him:”

### **1Corinthians 15:34**

“Awake to righteousness, and sin not...”

### **Romans 1:14**

“For sin shall not have dominion over you: for ye are not under the law, but under grace.”

## **THE LAW**

Under the new dispensation, we are not under the law of Moses.

Romans 4:25 says that forgiveness and justification comes solely by faith in the finished works of Jesus.

### **Romans 3:20-22:**

“Therefore, by the deeds of the law there shall no flesh be justified in his sight: for by the law is the knowledge of sin. But now the righteousness of God without the law is manifested, being witnessed by the law and the prophets; Even the righteousness of God which is by faith of Jesus Christ unto all and upon all them that believe: for there is no difference”

### **Romans 8:3**

“For what the law could not do, in that it was weak through the flesh, God sending his own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh, and for sin, condemned sin in the flesh:”

### **Galatians 3:23-27**

“Before the coming of this faith, we were held in custody under the law, locked up until the faith that was to come would be revealed. So the law was our guardian until Christ came that we might be justified by faith. Now that this faith has come, we are no longer under a guardian. So, in Christ Jesus you are all children of God through faith, for all of you who were baptized into Christ have clothed yourselves with Christ.”

### **Romans 10:4**

“For Christ is the end of the law for righteousness to everyone that believeth.”

The bible clearly states the purpose of the law in Romans 3:19:

“Obviously, the law applies to those to whom it was given, for its purpose is to keep people from having excuses, and to show that the entire world is guilty before God” (NLT Translation)

We see that the law was given to the Jews and its purpose was to make every man aware of his guilt and need for salvation. For with the law is the knowledge of sin.

The law contained types and shadows foretelling the coming of Christ. Now that Christ has come, we are no longer supposed to operate with types and shadows. Rather, we should lay hold on the substance, which is Jesus Christ.

**Romans 3: 20(NLT):** For no one can ever be made right with God by doing what the law commands. The law simply shows us how sinful we are.

So, anyone who attempts to be righteous by the law or by his own ability is wasting his time. For the righteousness of works is like filthy rag. But thank God for the gift of righteousness we have in Christ Jesus.

**Romans 3:20-25(NLT):**

“But now God has shown us a way to be made right with him without keeping the requirements of the law, as was promised in the writings of Moses and the prophets long ago. We are made right with God by placing our faith in Jesus Christ. And this is true for everyone who

believes, no matter who we are.

For everyone has sinned; we all fall short of God's glorious standard.

24 Yet God, in his grace, freely makes us right in his sight. He did this through Christ Jesus when he freed us from the penalty for our sins. For God presented Jesus as the sacrifice for sin."

Hallelujah!

So, receive and acknowledge God's grace and righteousness with joy and thanksgiving, your life will never remain the same. Reign and be victorious, because this is God's will for you. As a Christian, you shouldn't consider or call yourself a sinner anymore. Bear fruits consistent to your nature. Christ has done the work. Live out your righteousness!

### **Romans 8: 33-34**

"Who shall lay anything to the charge of God's elect? It is God that justifieth. 34 Who is he that condemneth? It is Christ that died, yea rather, that is risen again, who is even at the right hand of God, who also maketh intercession for us."

Rejoice, rejoice, you are holy, unblameable and unproveable. You are accepted in the beloved.

### **Isaiah 61:10**

"I will greatly rejoice in the LORD, my soul shall be joyful in my God; for he hath clothed me with the garments of salvation, he hath covered me with the robe of righteousness, as a bridegroom decketh himself with ornaments, and as a bride adorneth herself with her jewels."



# CHAPTER III

## THE HOLY SPIRIT

### **Isaiah 60:1**

The Spirit of the Lord is upon me,  
because he hath anointed me to  
preach the gospel to the poor; he hath  
sent me to heal the broken-hearted, to  
preach deliverance to the captives,  
and recovering of sight to the blind, to  
set at liberty them that are bruised.

Before we proceed in this chapter, I want to introduce you to the wisest, most important and most powerful person on earth. He is called the Holy Spirit. He is the Spirit of Jesus. And his home is in the believer. He is known as:

The power of the highest

The spirit of glory

The spirit of grace

The spirit of supplication

The spirit of wisdom and understanding

The spirit of counsel and might

The spirit of knowledge and the fear of the lord

The spirit of truth

The spirit of promise

The spirit of life.

This is the person that led the Israelites in the wilderness, the person that made a virgin to conceive, the person that made Elijah run faster than chariots, the person that made Saul prophesy, the source of Samson's strength.

He is the spirit of impossibilities. He was the one who hovered across the deep in the beginning.

This is the person that Joel and many other prophets prophesied about, he is the spirit of God.

He is he who God promised. He is the gift of God. He is God.

## **THE PROMISE HAS COME**

### **Joel2:28**

“And it shall come to pass afterward, that I will pour out my spirit upon all flesh; and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, your old men shall dream dreams, your young men shall see visions.”

After the death of Jesus, He appeared to his disciples and instructed them to wait for the spirit, as promised in the book of Joel.

### **Acts 1:4**

“And, being assembled together with them, commanded them that they should not depart from Jerusalem, but wait for the promise of the spirit. For John truly baptized with water; but ye shall be baptized with the Holy Ghost not many days hence.”

Before he went to the cross, Jesus told his disciples that it was better he left so the Holy Spirit will come to them.

### **John 16:7**

“Nevertheless, I tell you the truth; it is expedient for you that I go away: for if I go not away, the Comforter will not come unto you; but if I depart, I will send him unto you.”

This statement amongst many others demonstrates just how important the spirit of God is in our lives.

One of the great blessings of Christianity is that we have been made to have the same kind of relationship with God that Jesus has with him and this is made possible because of the Spirit of God in us. By the Spirit of God, we have been brought into fellowship with the Father and the Son.

It was impossible for the disciples to fully understand the mystery of the gospel before the Holy Ghost came upon them.

### **John 16:12 & 13:**

“I have yet many things to say unto you, but ye cannot bear them now. Howbeit when he, the Spirit of truth, is come, he will guide you into all truth: for he shall not speak of himself; but whatsoever he shall hear, that shall he speak: and he will shew you things to come.”

The spirit today makes the testimony of Christ real to us. The Holy Spirit reveals Jesus to us and our identity in him.

## **1 Corinthians 2:9-12**

“But as it is written, Eye hath not seen, nor ear heard, neither have entered into the heart of man, the things which God hath prepared for them that love him.

10 But God **hath** revealed them unto us by his Spirit: for the Spirit searcheth all things, yea, the deep things of God. 11 For what man knoweth the things of a man, save the spirit of man which is in him? even so the things of God knoweth no man, but the Spirit of God. 12 Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the spirit which is of God; that we might know the things that are freely given to us of God.”

## **EFFECT OF THE SPIRIT**

### **Isaiah 32:13-15**

“Upon the land of my people shall come up thorns and briers; yea, upon all the houses of joy in the joyous city: Because the palaces shall be forsaken; the multitude of the city shall be left; the forts and towers shall be for dens forever, a joy of wild asses, a pasture of flocks; Until the spirit be poured upon us from on high, and the wilderness be a fruitful field, and the fruitful field be counted for a forest.”

The presence of God brings fruitfulness, it brings increase, it brings colour and it brings joy.

The presence of God brings liberation. Notice that the yoke is broken not by the anointing but because of the anointing (Isaiah 10:27). Be conscious of this anointing and your life will be transformed. You cannot be yoked because you are anointed.

In 1Chronicles 13:14, Obeddom and his household were blessed just because of the presence of the Ark of the Covenant. How much more blessed are we today. God himself dwells in us!

We are not alone; we have a father, teacher and comforter in us. He will be with us forever.

### **John 14:16**

“And I will pray the Father, and he shall give you another Comforter, that he may abide with you forever”

### **John 14:26**

“But the Comforter, which is the Holy Ghost, whom the Father will send in my name, he shall teach you all things, and bring all things to your remembrance, whatsoever I have said unto you.”

The word ‘Comforter’ is translated from the Greek word ‘Parakletos’. Parakletos has seven translations in English. These are Counselor, Advocate, Helper, Intercessor, Comforter, Standby and Strengtheners. These translations give us an idea of the various things the Holy Spirit does in a believer.

He is our ever-present help. He is our strength. You never lack wisdom; you have an excellent counsellor. Consult him always.

### **Guarantee of salvation.**

When we received the gospel of Jesus, we received his spirit by faith.

### **Galatians 3:2**

“This only would I learn of you, Received ye the Spirit by the works of the law, or by the hearing of faith?”

To be saved means to be born again, which also means to be in Christ, which also means to receive the Holy Spirit.

John the Baptist baptised with water; Jesus came to baptise with his

Spirit. (Luke 3:16).

Jesus has promised that this Spirit will be in us forever!

The Holy Spirit is our guarantee of salvation. We will be raised by the Spirit the same way Christ was raised because the Spirit dwells in us.

### **Romans 8:11**

“But if the Spirit of him that raised up Jesus from the dead dwell in you, he that raised up Christ from the dead shall also quicken your mortal bodies by his Spirit that dwelleth in you.”

### **Ephesians 1:13-14 (Amplified)**

“In Him, you also, when you heard the word of truth, the good news of your salvation, and [as a result] believed in Him, were stamped with the **seal** of the promised Holy Spirit [the One promised by Christ] as owned and protected [by God]. 14 The Spirit is the guarantee [the first instalment, the pledge, a foretaste] of our inheritance until the redemption of God’s own [purchased] possession [His believers], to the praise of His glory.”

Hallelujah! The Spirit is our guarantee. He is God’s seal on our lives. Christ in us, the hope of Glory!

So, as believers, we do not fear death. Death has been swallowed up in victory. For we know that as Christ was raised from hades, so also will we.

When we got born again, we were born into Christ by the Holy Ghost. Now we are His temple, God himself dwells in us through his Spirit. And in the last day, we will be raised up by the same Holy Spirit.

Those that have received the spirit can boldly say- the father is in me, and I am in the father.

They can boldly say I am one with God.

Our body is no longer ours. We were bought with a price. Your body is now his body. Your hands are His hands; your eyes are his eyes. So, when you lay hands on the sick, it is as though God himself is the one laying his hands because your hands are his hands. Hallelujah!

The Spirit guides us. He teaches us. He guides us into all truths.

### **1John 2:27**

“But the anointing which ye have received of him abideth in you, and ye need not that any man teach you: but as the same anointing teacheth you of all things, and is truth, and is no lie, and even as it hath taught you, ye shall abide in him.”

Be conscious of this precious anointing. Fellowship with the spirit. Talk to him always. He wants to get involved in everything that concerns you. He's your closest friend, he is your Lord.

### **Who is this Comforter?**

The Holy Spirit is not a mysterious personality. The Holy Spirit is the Spirit of Jesus. Knowing Jesus is knowing the comforter.

### **John 14:16-18**

“And I will pray the Father, and he shall give you another Comforter, that he may abide with you for ever;

17 Even the Spirit of truth; whom the world cannot receive, because it seeth him not, neither knoweth him: but ye know him; for he dwelleth with

you, and shall be in you.

18 I will not leave you comfortless: I will come to you.”

Jesus told his disciples that they know the comforter who will abide with them forever. They know the comforter because he is the comforter. He was WITH them and he promised to be IN them. In verse 18, Jesus promised that he would come to them. And he has fulfilled that promise today. Hallelujah.

### **1 John 2:1**

“My little children, these things write I unto you, that ye sin not. And if any man sin, we have an advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous”

Jesus is our advocate. The word advocate in that verse is “parakletos” in Greek. That is the same word comforter. The Spirit of Jesus is our comforter.

This is why he said we can do the same works he did and even greater! Because he is alive today and alive in us.

## **TONGUES**

### **1Corinthians 14:39**

“Wherefore, brethren, covet to prophesy, and forbid not to speak with tongues.”

There are realms in the spirit that are unreachable for those who do not speak in tongues. Speaking in tongues is essential for spiritual growth.

### **1Corinthians 14:18**

“I thank my God I speak with tongues more than ye all.”

This was one major reason why Paul was such a success.

## **WHY TONGUES?**

To pray according to the will of God

To pray about future events and events that we are not aware of

For a greater fellowship with God in prayer.

For perseverance in Prayer

For thanksgiving

For prophecy through interpretation

For revelations from the Holy Spirit

To build, charge and edify yourself

It's a sign of a believe

For intercession

To increase our spiritual sensitivity

To energize our spirits

To give angels orders.

### **1 Corinthians 14:2**

“For he that speaketh in an unknown tongue speaketh not unto men, but unto God: for no man understandeth him; howbeit in the spirit he speaketh mysteries.”

Speaking in tongues is not for “special Christians” or “special occasions” or when a “special anointing” falls on you. Tongues is a gift for every Christian and like everything in the kingdom, it must be done in faith.

There is a false perception many believers have about speaking in tongues. Many believe tongues is “real” only when it can be understood by people of other languages. This is indeed incorrect, for the scripture says when we speak in tongues our understanding is unfruitful (1Corinthians 14:14).

It is only possible to understand your tongues when you are given an interpretation or when it is the tongues of men. Both of which are entirely different gifts of the spirit.

### **Mark 16:17**

“And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues;”

Jesus himself said speaking in tongues is a sign that should follow every believer. It should never be despised.

I have noticed that the more I speak in tongues, the more conscious I am of spiritual realities. Tongues is a treadmill for your spirit man.

Always be conscious of God in you.

He will never leave you. You can't hide from his presence. He loves you. You are his body; his temple. By the anointing, the fullness of His power dwells in you. You are the means through which He wants to impact the world.

That virtue that healed the woman with the issue of blood now resides in

you.

You are the representation of God. Your hands are his hands. Your eyes are his eyes. You are the body of God.

**1John 4:4**

“Ye are of God, little children, and have overcome them: because greater is he that is in you, than he that is in the world.”

# CHAPTER IV

## ANGELS

### **Hebrews 1:14**

Are they not all ministering spirits, sent forth to minister for them who shall be heirs of salvation?

This is one of the verses that excites me most in the bible. The word 'Angel' is gotten from the Greek word 'Aggelos'. The other English synonyms for angels are messengers, envoys, one sent along.

### **Hebrews 1:13-14**

But to which of the angels said he at any time, Sit on my right hand, until I make thine enemies thy footstool? Are they not all ministering spirits, sent forth to minister for them who shall be heirs of salvation?

This is wonderful; the bible says angels are ministering spirits sent by God to minister for those who are heirs to salvation. That's you, me and

every Christian everywhere. But very few Christians are aware that God has sent angels for them. They rarely employ the services of these angels. If angels were not necessary, God would never have made them available for man. God does not need angels! God's commandments to angels are towards the service of man.

### **Psalm 103:20-21**

Bless the LORD, ye his angels that excel in strength, that do his commandments, hearkening unto the voice of his word. Bless ye the LORD, all ye his hosts; ye ministers of his, that do his pleasure.

## **THEIR MINISTRY TO THE SAINTS**

### **-They protect.**

Angels are our spiritual "body guards". They follow us everywhere; it is their job.

They are always around us. But consciousness of their presence is very important.

Their impact and ministering to us is hugely limited if we are not conscious of their presence.

### **Galatians 4:1**

Now I say, that the heir, as long as he is a child, differeth nothing from a servant, though he be lord of all;

As heirs of salvation angels have been sent to accompany us, but their ministry becomes less effective if we are unaware of their presence.

2Kings 6 tells us a wonderful story about Elisha and his servant.

## **2Kings 6:15-18**

And when the servant of the man of God was risen early, and gone forth, behold, an host compassed the city both with horses and chariots. And his servant said unto him, Alas, my master! How shall we do?

And he answered, Fear not: for they that be with us are more than they that be with them.

And Elisha prayed, and said, LORD, I pray thee, open his eyes, that he may see. And the LORD opened the eyes of the young man; and he saw: and, behold, the mountain was full of horses and chariots of fire round about Elisha.

And when they came down to him, Elisha prayed unto the LORD, and said, Smite this people, I pray thee, with blindness. And he smote them with blindness according to the word of Elisha.

The king of Syria sent horses and chariots which surrounded the city just to capture one man. Naturally, Elisha's servant was scared to his bones. But Elisha operated in a supernatural realm. He might not have seen the angels but he was fully conscious of their ministry. But to help his servant, he prayed that God should open his servant's eyes to see the angels.

'Behold, the mountain was full of horses and chariots of fire round about Elisha'.

Chariots of fire! Glory to God.

Just imagine how our lives will be like if we are always conscious of horses and chariots of fire about us

So, fear not, 'for they that be with us are more than they that be with them'. The angels at our disposal are more than any opposition you will ever face.

### **Psalm 91:11-12**

For he shall give his angels charge over thee, to keep thee in all thy ways. They shall bear thee up in their hands, lest thou dash thy foot against a stone.

**-They obey our commands.**

### **1Peter 3:22**

Who is gone into heaven, and is on the right hand of God; angels and authorities and powers being made subject unto him.

The bible says we are seated together with Jesus at the right hand of God. (Ephesians 2:6)

This means that: In the name of Jesus, angels are subject to us also.

They are ministering spirits sent to minister for us.

We have the authority to give them instructions, send them on errands and tell them to accomplish certain things for us.

Abraham was familiar with the ministry of angels.

While looking for a wife for Isaac, he prayed to God to send his angel to go alongside his servant.

### **Genesis 24:40**

"And he said unto me, The LORD, before whom I walk, will send his

angel with thee, and prosper thy way; and thou shalt take a wife for my son of my kindred, and of my father's house.”

We should always be conscious of their presence, their strength and their ministry in our lives.

When we pray in tongues, instructions are given to angels to accomplish certain things for us.

We can also instruct them when we pray with our understanding.

It is comforting to know that God loves you and angels are always around you. Nothing should make any Christian afraid. Be conscious of these things and your life will never be the same.

### **Ephesians 6:10**

Be strong in the Lord and the power of His might.

# CHAPTER V

## AUTHORITY & POWER

### **Luke 9:1-2**

“Then he called his twelve disciples together, and gave them power and authority over all devils, and to cure diseases.

And he sent them to preach the kingdom of God, and to heal the sick”

Authority is lawful permission to execute power. Every spirit filled believer today has authority and power.

‘Power’ is gotten from the Greek word ‘Dunamis’. Dunamis refers to inherent ability to effect change.

Acts 1:8 says we received this inherent ability when we received the Holy Spirit.

### **Acts 1:8**

But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth.

It is one thing to have power, but yet another thing to have the right to exercise that power. The good news is that we don’t only have power, but

we also have authority to exercise the power in us.

Jesus was conscious of his divine authority. He proclaimed in John 5:21

**John 5:21**

“For as the Father raiseth up the dead, and quickeneth them; even so the Son quickeneth whom he will.”

**THE SOURCE OF OUR AUTHORITY**

Jesus is the source of our authority. He died in our place, he defeated the devil for us and when he was enthroned, we were enthroned with him.

**Ephesians 1:17-22**

“That the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give unto you the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of him: The eyes of your understanding being enlightened; that ye may know what is the hope of his calling, and what the riches of the glory of his inheritance in the saints, Which he wrought in Christ, when he raised him from the dead, and set him at his own right hand in the heavenly places, Far above all principality, and power, and might, and dominion, and every name that is named, not only in this world, but also in that which is to come: And hath put all things under his feet, and gave him to be the head over all things to the church,”

Verse 19 talks about the unlimited greatness of God’s power for us through faith. This was the same power that raised Jesus from the dead. Also, as we read on, we discover that Jesus was raised to sit at the right hand of God. This seat is a seat of authority. A seat that is above all power, principality, might, dominion and name.

This is wonderful. Many of us already know this. We know that Jesus is above all and that he has all authority. But very few Christians know that God has also given them that same authority.

Verse 5-6 of the next chapter:

### **Ephesians 2:5-6**

“Even when we were dead in sins, hath quickened us together with Christ, (by grace ye are saved;) And hath raised us up together and made us sit together in heavenly places in Christ Jesus.”

This is marvelous, we are seated together with Christ. We are also seated together in the seat of authority.

Notice that in Ephesians 1:22, Jesus is head of all things to the Church.

Jesus' victory is our victory. All things are under his feet. We are the body of Christ. God has placed all things under our feet in Christ Jesus.

A daily consciousness of this reality will transform your life. You'll think, talk and act differently. You'll realize that your words are powerful and that you can shape the course of life by your declarations.

You'll do the seemingly impossible, because God has given you his power and authority.

### **Mark 16:17**

“And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.”

The name of Jesus is the reason we are able to function in his authority.

The name of Jesus is the authority or rank of Jesus. This rank is higher than any other rank in heaven, on earth or under the earth. (Philippians 2:10)

### **Matthew 28:18**

“And Jesus came and spake unto them, saying, All power is given unto me in heaven and in earth”

The power in the verse above is not ‘Dunamis’, but ‘Exousia’. ‘Exousia’ is Greek word for authority. So now we can also boldly say: all authority is given unto me in heaven and on earth in the name of Jesus.

It is not a prayer, it is reality.

### **John 14:12-14**

“Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater works than these shall he do; because I go unto my Father. 13And whatsoever ye shall ask in my name, that will I do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son. 14If ye shall ask any thing in my name, I will do it.”

The above verses of scripture further reveal the glorious grace and blessing it is to live in the name of Jesus. Jesus said we can do the works that he did and even greater. Why? Because he is at the right hand of the father and we are sitted in him.

He went futher to say that whatever we ask in His name he will do. This is beyond prayer. Jesus taught us to pray to the Father in his name. However, in this instance, he is not talking about prayer. This is more like a declaration or a command. Whatever we command, because of the authority of Jesus, he will do it! Hallelujah!

**Philippians 2:8-11:**

“And being found in fashion as a man, he humbled himself, and became obedient unto death, even the death of the cross.

9Wherefore God also hath highly exalted him, and given him a name which is above every name:

10That at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of things in heaven, and things in earth, and things under the earth;

11And that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father”

Jesus has been given a name far above every other name. And that name is Lord!

For it pleased the father that all fullness should dwell in him. (Colossians 1:19)

So, go heal the sick in the name/authority of Jesus. Raise the dead in the name of Jesus.

Perform signs and wonders because you have Dunamis and Exousia.

**Ecclesiastics 8:4**

“Where the word of a king is, there is power: and who may say unto him, What doest thou?”

# CHAPTER VI

## Oneness

### **1Corinthians 6:17**

He that is joined unto the Lord is one Spirit.

Of all the seven in-Christ realities highlighted in this book, this is the one that, for a lack of better word, fascinates me the most. It was actually not in my original write-up. However, I was recently led by the Spirit to include it.

I went to God in prayer inquiring about the details of this chapter. And the Holy Spirit kept bringing this scripture to me. "He that is joined to the Lord is one spirit".

Oneness with God himself. This is sometimes too difficult to grasp. Why would the one and only true God decide to be one with man? What manner of love is that? I am in awe of this grace.

### **Hebrews 1:3**

"God, who at sundry times and in divers manners spake in time past unto the fathers by the prophets,

2 Hath in these last days spoken unto us by his Son, whom he hath appointed heir of all things, by whom also he made the worlds;

3 Who being the brightness of his glory, and the express image of his person, and upholding all things by the word of his power, when he had by himself purged our sins, sat down on the right hand of the Majesty on high;"

3 (Easy Translation): “The Son shows us completely what God is like. He shines with the great light of God himself. His nature and God's nature are the same. The Son's powerful word causes everything to continue. He himself made it possible for us to be clean from our sins. After he had done that, he returned to heaven. He went and he sat at the right side of God, who rules with all authority”

From the above verses, we see that Jesus is the expression, revelation and accurate representation of God. I love the Easy translation of verse 3 in particular, it says that Jesus shows us Completely what God is like. Prior to the coming of Christ, nobody truly knew or fully comprehended the nature of God. In Christ, we see God revealed. The verse goes on to say that the son has the same nature as the father.

No wonder Jesus said-- “if you have seen me you have seen the father.”  
(John 14:9)

## **Called into Oneness**

Oneness with the son is God's will. Many Christians have known and believed this reality. However, many of us are yet to fully grasp the implication of this. What does it mean to be in Christ? What does it mean to be the body of Christ?

In the opening verse of this chapter, we saw that – the one that is joined to the lord is one spirit with Him. This is what it means to be a Christian. We become one with Jesus. We become his expression on earth. Fully clothed by him. Such that; where we are, he is and where he is, we are.

## **Galatians 2:20**

“I am crucified with Christ: nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Christ liveth in

me: and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by the faith of the Son of God, who loved me, and gave himself for me.”

### **Galatians 3:27**

“For as many of you as have been baptized into Christ have put on Christ.”

This was always God’s plan. That his sons and daughters might be one with him. Just as Jesus is the revelation of the father, God wants the world to see him when they look at us.

We see more of this in Jesus’ prayer in John 17:

**Verse 11:** “And now I am no more in the world, but these are in the world, and I come to thee. Holy Father, keep through thine own name those whom thou hast given me, that they may be one, as we are.”

That they may be one, as we are. This is amazing. It was God’s will that all his children come into oneness with him. Just like Jesus!

Oneness with God was a major component of Jesus’ prayer for us in this chapter. We see more of that in the following verses.

**Verse 20:** Neither pray I for these alone, but for them also which shall believe on me through their word

**Verse 21:** That they all may be one; as thou, Father, art in me, and I in thee, that they also may be one in us: that the world may believe that thou hast sent me.

**Verse 22:** And the glory which thou givest me I have given them; that they may be one, even as we are one:

**Verse 23:** I in them, and thou in me, that they may be made perfect in

one; and that the world may know that thou hast sent me, and hast loved them, as thou hast loved me

Hallelujah! This is not just for the twelve disciples. It is for all that believe in Jesus. Verse 21 says—that we all may be one. All of us, one with God!

We have become members of Christ body. Inseparable and indistinguishable. We have his nature; we've been called into oneness. Called to display his glory on earth.

What are the implications of this? How should my life be like now that I am one with God? What is God's idea of oneness?

In verse 21 of John chapter 17, Jesus says our oneness with God will make the world believe in him. In other words, our oneness will bear certain fruits and produce certain results that will be too hard to ignore.

Being one with God means that God has decided to walk through us, to see through us, to heal through us, to talk through us, to bless through us, to function on the earth through us. Such that if anyone wants an encounter with God, all they need is to have an encounter with us. Because the wisdom of God that brings salvation flows through us, the love of God flows through us, the power of God flows through us.

### **Ephesians 5: 30-33**

“For we are members of his body, of his flesh, and of his bones.

31For this cause shall a man leave his father and mother, and shall be joined unto his wife, and they two shall be one flesh.

32This is a great mystery: but I speak concerning Christ and the church.”

### **1 Corinthians 12:12-14**

“For as the body is one, and hath many members, and all the members of that one body, being many, are one body: so also, is Christ.

13 For by one Spirit are we all baptized into one body, whether we be Jews or Gentiles, whether we be bond or free; and have been all made to drink into one Spirit.”

## **The family of God**

We must all realize that all who have received Christ have been made members of God’s family.

Like Apostle Paul said, we henceforth do not know any man or woman according to the flesh (2Corinthians 5:16).

We have all been made partakers of the same body.

Just as a body, though one, has many parts, but all its many parts form one body, so it is with Christ (1 corinthians 12:12 NIV).

As we grow in the knowledge of our oneness with God, we ought to also grow in love and in the knowledge of our oneness with each other.

It does not matter the denomination, it doesn’t matter where we are located in the planet, we are united in our faith in Christ and we ought to act that way.

### **1 Corinthians 3:6-9:**

“I have planted, Apollos watered; but God gave the increase.

7 So then neither is he that planteth any thing, neither he that watereth; but God that giveth the increase.

8 Now he that planteth and he that watereth are **one**: and every man shall receive his own reward according to his own labour.”

**Ephesians 2:19**

“Now therefore ye are no more strangers and foreigners, but fellow citizens with the saints, and of the household of God.”

# CHAPTER VII

## ETERNAL LIFE

### **1John 1:2**

For the life was manifested, and we have seen it, and bear witness, and show unto you that eternal life, which was with the Father, and was manifested unto us.

There is a human nature and a divine nature/life. The divine life or eternal life is the life God possesses.

Every one of us was born with a human nature. But that all changed when we became born again. At new birth your human nature is replaced with a divine life.

### **2Corinthians 5:17**

“Therefore, if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.”

Every Christian is a citizen of heaven and possesses eternal life.

This life is translated as ‘Zoe’ in Greek. It is the God kind of life.

### **John 3:16**

“For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that

whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.”

Those in Christ have received an indestructible life. By dying and resurrecting from the dead, Jesus Christ defeated the grave for all those who put their trust in him.

### **2 Timothy 1:8-10:**

“Be not thou therefore ashamed of the testimony of our Lord, nor of me his prisoner: but be thou partaker of the afflictions of the gospel according to the power of God; 9 Who hath saved us, and called us with an holy calling, not according to our works, but according to his own purpose and grace, which was given us in Christ Jesus before the world began, 10 But is now made manifest by the appearing of our Saviour Jesus Christ, who hath abolished death, and hath brought life and immortality to light through the gospel:”

Death has been abolished! Hallelujah! In the gospel, we see life and immortality revealed in the victory of Jesus. The phrase ‘you only live once’ doesn’t hold true for the Christian. This is because we know we never die. We do not live once, we live forever. We have lost the ability to die. Even if our earthly body perishes, our spirits live forever. And at the resurrection, we will be given a new body as the scripture says.

### **2 Corinthians 5:1 & 6-8**

“For we know that if our earthly house of this tabernacle were dissolved, we have a building of God, an house not made with hands, eternal in the heavens.

Therefore, we are always confident, knowing that, whilst we are at home in the body, we are absent from the Lord:

7 (For we walk by faith, not by sight:)

8 We are confident, I say, and willing rather to be absent from the body, and to be present with the Lord.”

## **PARTAKERS OF THE DIVINE NATURE**

God has called us Gods. He has given us the God life and his dream is that we reign as Kings and ambassadors on this earth.

We are partakers of the divine nature, God’s very own nature.

### **2Peter 1:4**

“Whereby are given unto us exceeding great and precious promises: that by these ye might be partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust.”

Jesus was conscious of this life. We should also be conscious of this zoe.

He declared in John chapter five:

### **John 5:26**

“For as the Father hath life in himself; so hath he given to the Son to have life in himself;”

As the father has Zoe in himself, so has he given you to have zoe in yourself.

This was the reason why Jesus had the boldness to touch a leprous man. He was not afraid of getting leprosy, he knew he had eternal life.

This life we have cannot be affected by sickness, diseases or any type of virus or bacteria.

## **ETERNAL LIFE IS A PRESENT-DAY REALITY**

Many Christians think that eternal life is a thing of the future. Maybe we will get it after our time on earth. However, they are wrong to think that way.

The Holy Spirit in 1John chapter 5 lets us know that eternal life is for every Christian today.

### **1John 5:11-13**

“And this is the record that God hath given to us eternal life, and this life is in the son. He that hath the son hath life; and he that hath not the son of God hath not life. These things have I written unto you that believe on the name of the son of God; that you may know that you have eternal life.”

The bible clearly states that he that has the son HAS life. HAS is present tense. Eternal life is a present-day reality.

Eternal life can be accessed only through Jesus. He came that we might not die but have eternal life through him.

If you have Jesus, you have ZOE.

## **SONS OF GOD**

### **John 3:6**

“That which is born of the flesh is flesh; that which is born of the Spirit is spirit.”

Every Christian is a child of God, begotten of the father, born from above. We have God’s very own DNA.

### **John 1:12-13**

“..But as many as received him, to them gave He gave power to become

the sons of God, even to them that believe on his name. Which were born not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but of God.”

Whatever is born of flesh is flesh. Whatever is born of Spirit is Spirit. God is the source of our life and the nature of our lives can only be discovered in Him. For as he is, so are we!

John, in the spirit exclaimed:

**1John 3:1**

“Behold, what manner of love the Father hath bestowed upon us, that we should be called the sons of God.”

**Psalm 82:6**

“I have said ye are gods; and all of you are children of the most high.”

Glory to God forever.

**NOW THAT YOU HAVE BEEN EQUIPED**

Meditate on these things. Give yourself wholly to them, that your profiting may appear to all.

Go forth and manifest God’s glory in all your endeavours.

Preach the gospel with the demonstration of the Spirit and power.

Show God’s love to all.

Finally, brethren, rejoice in the Lord always: and again I say, rejoice.
